Who is eligible?

Qualifications for Boy Scout Youth

- Must be registered with BSA with a troop
- Must be at least First class rank
- Must be 12 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree (July 15). Cannot have reached your 18th birthday by the last day of the Jamboree
- Be approved by the Unit leader and Concho Valley Council
- Participate in pre-Jamboree trainings
- File a Jamboree personal health and medical record prior to any pre Jamboree training-
- Submit an online reservation at the National Jamboree website
- Follow Concho Valley Council's fee schedule

Qualifications for Venture Scouts

- Must be currently registered with BSA and a Venture Crew
- Must have graduated the 8th grade or be at least 14 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree, but have not reached your 21st birthday by the last day of the Jamboree.
- Be approved by the Unit leader and Concho Valley Council
- Participate in pre-Jamboree trainings
- File a Jamboree personal health and medical record prior to any pre Jamboree training.
- Submit an online reservation the National Jamboree website
- Follow Concho Valley Council's fee schedule.



How will we get there?

Travel will be by plane from San Angelo to Washington DC.

Tour Washington for 2 days.

From Washington you will travel by bus to the Jamboree site.

Jamboree will be held for 10 days.

After the Jamboree:

you will travel by bus to the airport and fly home to San Angelo.

Adult leadership

There will be six adults on the trip. Currently those leaders are: Butch Simpson, Harold Sharp, Chris Shrum, Brenda White and Mary Ann Payton. An opening for an 18–25 year old (preferably an Eagle Scout) is available.

COST?

Total fee is \$2700.

This covers all fees for the Jamboree and travel expenses. Uniform patches, caps and t shirts are included in this price. Uniform shirts, shorts, belt and socks are not included in this total fee.

Required by the end

of December 2011:

\$850 deposit.

The remaining fee can be paid out with monthly payments through May of 2013.
