## HOW FAMILY CAMP WORKS

1. A registered TIGER, CUB SCOUT, or WEBELO SCOUT will bring his **mom, dad, adult partner or entire family** to Camp Sol Mayer to experience FUN.
2. Check in begins at 5:30 on Friday. Friday night program will be "The Space Cinema". Saturday registration will begin at 8:30 a.m. Camp ends on Sunday at 10 a.m.
3. Set up your tent (or rent one of ours\*) and settle into your camping area. Each campsite has water but no lighting. Hot showers & Bathrooms are located nearby.  
*\*Our tents are 7 X 9 wall tents with no floor or bug screens. Call the Council office to reserve a tent. Rental fee is \$10.00 per tent for weekend use.*
4. Opening ceremonies start at 10:00 am on Saturday. **Meals will not be served.** All meals will be prepared by the Cubs and their families in the campsites (get together with others from your Pack to share the cooking responsibilities).
5. Each Cub and family will participate in outdoor fun events and games until supper time.
6. You may participate in an exciting campfire program Saturday evening with skits, songs and more fun!
7. Non-denominational worship service will be held on Sunday morning.
8. Crafts, patches, other camp memorabilia and refreshments may be purchased at our camp trading post during the day and evening.
9. All areas of the camp will be available for fishing, hiking or just walking around during your stay.
10. Packs camping on Friday night must file a Tour permit with the Council office. Don't forget that WEATHER HAZARD training is required for the permit.

**NO PETS ALLOWED AT CAMP.**

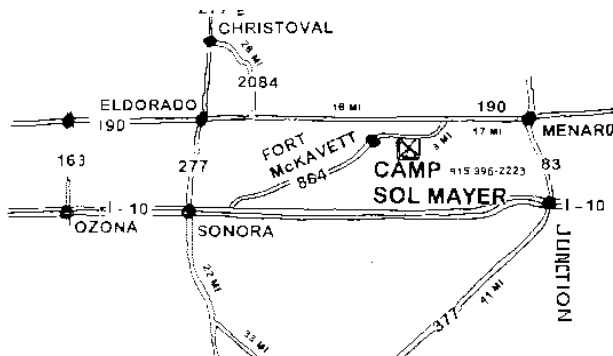
# WHAT IS FAMILY CAMP?
