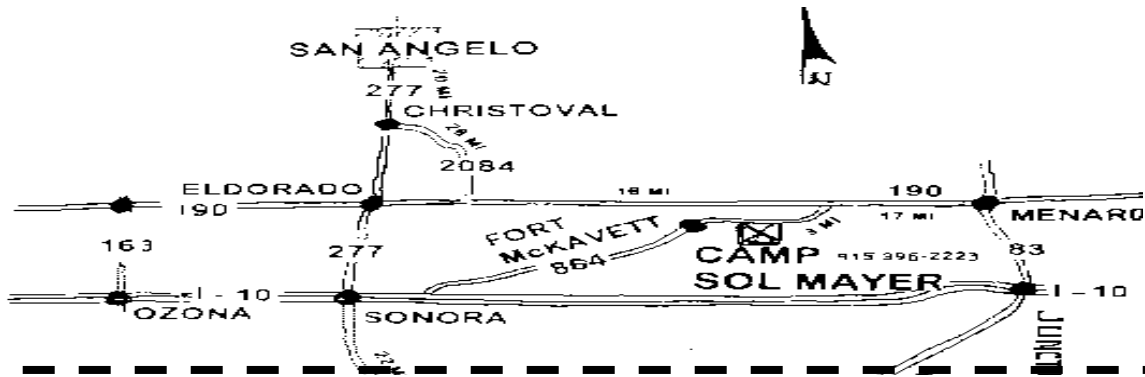
What to Bring

Camp Sol Mayer is located on Highway 864, 5 miles East of Ft. McKavett, Texas. Turn off Highway 190, 17 miles West of Menard to Highway 86, and go 3 miles

Pets: No pets are allowed in camp. Please notify the council office at the time of registration if you are bringing a service animal.

Late Registration: In order to properly plan the camp activities, no registrations can be accepted the day of camp. All registrations must be received by the final registration deadline.

Training: All adults in camp must have Youth Protection Training. This is to comply with state laws for child safety.

Most importantly: Camp events are intended to be fun with a purpose. We want all of our campers to have a good time while learning and growing together as Cub Scouts.
